Promotion of social and economic development through micro-projects



The programme of micro-projects of the Embassy of the Federal Republic of Germany provides funds to local beneficiaries under the aspect of social, humanitarian and charitable assistance. Its focus is on underprivileged groups in the society.

Applications for 2019 have to be submitted by 01 March, 2019.

Which kinds of projects can be funded?

The programme aims at supporting independent measures in the field of social and economic development that can be funded from the initial stage to its final completion. The implementation of the project should be completed within a period of three months or, at the latest, before the end of October of the current year. After completion of the project no further payments can be claimed. The approval of the Israeli authorities for the project is mandatory.

Projects for children and young people in rural areas and for disabled people, as well as measures aimed at empowering women and at engaging people from different cultural or religious backgrounds at community level are particularly welcome.

Who can apply?

Applications may be submitted by NGOs, self-help-groups and communities based in Israel.

What is the amount of support?

The allocation depends on the income and the costs of a project. Therefore an effective financial plan has to be submitted with the application.

In general the support must not exceed the equivalent of 5.000 Euro in NIS. Applicants are expected to bear a reasonable share of the costs of the project. Costs for personnel as well as “overhead charges” cannot be funded.

Application modalities

Requested attachments to the application form are:

- ✓ Information about the applicant
- ✓ Documentation about the proposed project
- ✓ Effective financial plan including own contribution of the beneficiary and third party donation

The time limit for submission ends on **01 March, 2019**. Only complete applications will be considered in the selection process.

Please note:

After completion of the project the beneficiary has to present a detailed final report (with photos) together with a proof of employments of funds and the original invoices and receipts.

The language of communication with the Embassy is English.

The selection process is being conducted in March 2019.
