



Data protection declaration pursuant to Article 13 of the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)

The Federal Foreign Office and the German Embassy in Tel Aviv will use your personal data to process your application and a financial support of your project. Personal data means any information relating to an identified or identifiable natural person. We would like to provide the following information regarding our data processing in order to comply with our obligation under Article 13 of the GDPR:

3. Your personal data will be processed for the purposes of deciding about the allocation of funds and controlling the use of the funds. The legal basis for processing is Article 6 (1 e) GDPR in connection with § 3 FDPA, as the processing is necessary for the performance of a task assigned to us in the public interest or in the exercise of official authority.

4. Your personal data will be stored for at least one year by the German Embassy in Tel Aviv, regardless of whether your application is successful. In case an allocation is granted, we generally store the data for a period of five years.

5. As a data subject, you have the following rights if the relevant conditions have been met:

- Right of access (Article 15 of the GDPR),
- Right to rectification (Article 16 of the GDPR),
- Right to erasure (Article 17 of the GDPR),
- Right to restriction of processing (Article 18 of the GDPR),
- Right to data portability (Article 20 of the GDPR),
- Right to object to processing (Article 21 of the GDPR).

6. You also have the right to complain to a data protection authority about the processing of your personal data. The supervisory authority responsible for the Federal Foreign Office is:
